Subject: Conflict Minerals

To Whom it May Concern:

In July 2010, President Obama signed into law H.R. 4173, the Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Section 1502 of that act imposes reporting requirements on manufacturers of products that contain metals derived from minerals that originate in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or an adjoining country. These "conflict minerals" include columbite-tantalite (for the elements niobium, tantalum), cassiterite, (for the element tin), wolframite, (for the element tungsten), gold, their derivatives or any others so designated by the U.S. Secretary of State.

Electri-Flex Company, a domestic manufacturer of a wide variety of Flexible Electrical Conduits, has canvassed its raw material suppliers and has determined that no products produced by Electri-Flex contain any of the restricted minerals listed above.
